This template is useful to link to data which is located in the "linked_suff" directory on our server. This directory is meant to enable links to data which cannot be handled via the wiki software's linking sytem.

Usage

```
{{Linked_stuff|subdirectory or path to the file to include|description to display}}
```

e.g.

```
{{Linked_stuff|Annotation/contamination/bacterial_genes_masked.xls|bacterial_genes_masked.xls}}
```

results in: [bacterial_genes_masked.xls](#)
